



Odd Society Spirits is proud to offer you the opportunity to own your own private share of a 113 litre cask of Canadian Whisky. This year, you can choose from:

- single malt
- peated rye whisky
- pecan wood smoked single malt

Your whisky will age for four years and will be bottled for you to enjoy. During this time, you can follow the aging process with an annual tasting.

This limited offer includes

1/4 (25%) share of a 113 litre barrel of Odd Society Single Malt or Rye barrelled at approximately 60% ABV

Storage for four years while the spirit matures—Single Malt in once-used American White Oak ex Bourbon casks, and Rye in new American Oak, peat smoked casks.

Bonding and insurance for four years

Tasting at the Odd Society Distillery in year one, year two and year three.

Frequently Asked Questions



Can I keep my cask at home?

Sadly, no. Liquor regulations prohibit the sale and delivery of bulk spirits to individuals so we will hold your spirits while they age and then bottle them on site for you.

What about bottles, labels, corks and taxes?

All are included in the bottling price of \$650.

Can I get my own personalized labels?

Yes! Personalized labels are possible, but at the expense of the purchaser. All labels must meet the labelling regulations set out by the Canadian Food and Inspection Agency and be ready and approved prior to bottling. We are happy to provide you with the required information.

How many bottles will I get?

You will receive 40 750ml or 80 375ml bottles at 40% ABV

Evaporation?

As your spirit matures, the cask contents decrease due to evaporation, which is completely normal. In Scotland, it's called the "Angel's Share". Losses per year are expected to be approximately 7% per year for a barrel of this size.

What percentage will it be?

We bottle with a filling strength of 40% ABV.

Is this Whisky?

Not yet, but it will be! Canadian liquor regulations forbid us from calling anything that hasn't been aged for three years a whisky. So while it ages in the cask, we'll call it a Single Malt or Rye spirit, but when it's done aging we can officially call it Canadian Whisky.

Small Print

- All tax included: Federal Excise Tax, provincial LDB markup, GST and PST.
- Payment in full for the cask contents required at time of ordering
- Bottling costs are \$650, payable when you pick up your bottles. This money also covers excise, etc.
